The Board action will not have an impact on LACMTA's safety standards



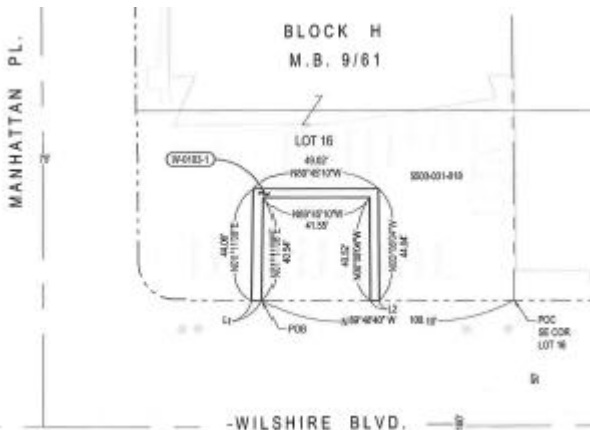
