Award a firm fixed unit rate Contract No. OP91160(3)001R1 for Region 1 to Strive Well-Being, Inc., to provide graffiti abatement services in the not-to-exceed (NTE) amount of \$2,683,930 for the three-year base period, and \$1,991,400 for the one, two-year option, for a combined NTE amount of \$4,675,330, effective October 1, 2025, subject to resolution of properly submitted protest(s), if any; and
- B. Award a firm fixed unit rate Contract No. OP91160(3)002R2 for Region 2 to BriteWorks, Inc., to provide graffiti abatement services in the NTE amount of \$3,436,171 for the three-year base period, and \$2,458,952 for the one, two-year option, for a combined NTE amount of \$5,895,123, effective October 1, 2025, subject to resolution of properly submitted protest(s), if any; and
- C. Award a firm fixed unit rate Contract No. OP91160(3)003R3 for Region 3 to Urban Graffiti Enterprises Inc., to provide graffiti abatement services in the NTE amount of \$5,002,335 for the three-year base period, and \$3,334,890 for the one, two-year option, for a combined NTE amount of \$8,337,225, effective October 1, 2025, subject to resolution of properly submitted protest(s), if any.

<u>ISSUE</u>

The existing regional contracts providing graffiti abatement services expire on September 30, 2025. The three (3) new contract awards are required to ensure continuity of maintenance services, effective October 1, 2025.

DISCUSSION

Under these new graffiti abatement maintenance services contracts, the contractors are required to:

- Perform daily inspections throughout Metro's system.
- Remove all accessible graffiti observed by the contractor within the same day.
- Remove all reported accessible graffiti within 48 hours, and reported nonaccessible graffiti must be removed expeditiously upon securing approved track allocation and support.
- Graffiti will be removed using chemical removal agents, a rag, pressurized hot water, and paint-out methods.

DISCUSSION (Continued...)

- Regular graffiti abatement services are essential for Metro facilities to maintain a safe and clean environment.
- Approximately 4,000 graffiti tags are removed monthly from Metro facilities, Rights-Of-Way (ROWs), parking lots, and parcel properties, continuing our longstanding practice of zero tolerance for graffiti systemwide to enhance customer experience and improve Metro facilities' overall conditions.
- Under the terms of these new contracts, the number of Metro bus and rail stations, facilities, and locations will increase from 533 to 552, including 19 additional locations for the D line (Purple) Westside Extensions, and A Line (Blue) Foothill Extension Phase 2B system expansion projects as they become operational.
