




Systemwide Crime Stats

August 2025

- Crimes Against Persons decreased by 10.7% in August, mainly due to decreases in aggravated assaults and robberies.
 - This marks the <u>lowest total for August</u> <u>systemwide</u> since 2021.
- **Crimes Against Property** decreased by 4.1%, due to a decrease in thefts.
- Arrests for Crimes Against Society increased by 10.4%, due to increases in narcotics and trespassing arrests.
 - On August 4 and 25, LASD conducted an undercover operation at Filmore Station, resulting in a total of five arrests.
 - On August 11, LAPD conducted a crime suppression operation around North Hollywood Station, making a significant arrest for narcotics and loaded firearms.




Systemwide Crime Stats

August 2025 vs. August 2024

Per One Million Boardings

- Crimes Against Persons decreased by 15.8% in August (6.26 vs. 7.43).
 - It is also the <u>lowest rate of</u> <u>incidents seen for the</u> <u>month of August</u> since 2019.
- Crimes Against Property increased by 11.9% (2.81 vs. 2.51).
- Crimes Against Society decreased by 57.7% (15.16 vs. 35.84).

CUSTOMER SENTIMENT

 Reddit – a post on Reddit titled "I had a fun Metro Day trip today!" generated positive engagement, where the rider noted the new taller faregates at several stations along the B Line.

TRANSIT SECURITY

- TSOs issued 33 citations & 47 written warnings.
 - 83% of violations issued at TAP-to-Exit locations
 - Union Station & North Hollywood still had some citations due to continued efforts by MTS to enforce the Code of Conduct.

MTS also engages in educating patrons about having valid fare media on their TAP cards, explaining how TAP-to-Exit works, and overseeing the weapons detection pilot at designated stations.

Bus Safety Teams conducted EOL operations during Owl Service at Chatsworth and North Hollywood G Line Stations.

METRO AMBASSADORS

Ambassadors provide support to riders, connecting riders to resources and reporting safety incidents or maintenance needs.

- 4,845 cleanliness issues
- 2,127 graffiti incidents
- 744 elevator and escalator problems

END OF LINE OPERATIONS

Contract Security officers offload trains at 11 EOL rail stations.


Partnerships to Mitigate Societal Issues

Metro utilizes a care-based approach, collaborating with the Department of Health Services (DHS) and homeless service agencies to deploy multidisciplinary outreach teams (MDTs) across the rail and bus system.

Metro has also worked closely with other County departments to help identify programs and improve access to mental health and substance abuse resources.





Frontline Safety

- In August, there were 18 assaults on Metro frontline personnel.
- Using physical force, spitting, and using a weapon/object were the methods of assaults on operators.
 - In August, 1,537,464 revenue miles were traveled between each operator assault.
- Using physical force was the top method of assault on other frontline staff, followed by using a weapon/object/projectile and spitting.
