

### Narcan Data (June & July 2025)

MTS, LAPD, LASD, Contract Security, and Ambassadors are equipped with Narcan and administer it as needed to individuals experiencing symptoms of an overdose.

In June, there were a total of 10 Narcan incidents, which is an increase of one incident from the previous month (9). Ambassadors reported four incidents, LAPD reported three, Contract Security reported two, and MTS reported one, while LASD reported no incidents. Three of the Narcan incidents occurred on the B Line, three occurred at Union Station, one occurred on the A, C, G, and J Lines.

In July, there were a total of 12 Narcan incidents, which is an increase of two incidents from the prior month (10). Contract Security reported six incidents, Ambassadors reported four, LAPD and LASD each reported one, while MTS reported no incidents. Four of the Narcan incidents occurred on the A and B Lines, three occurred at Union Station, and one occurred at 7<sup>th</sup> Street / Metro Center Station.
