

**ACCEPTANCE OF STANDARDS OF COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICER
STANDARDS AND TRAINING**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY ACCEPTING THE REQUIREMENTS OF
SECTIONS 13510, 13512, AND 13522 OF THE CALIFORNIA PENAL CODE
RELATING TO THE RECRUITMENT AND TRAINING OF PEACE OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2024, the Board of Directors of the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) approved the establishment of the Transit Community Public Safety Department (now known as the Department of Public Safety); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety must adhere to the standards for recruitment and training set by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST); and

WHEREAS, POST also provides resources and benefits to over 600 member agencies in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety is recommending Metro join POST in order to receive the numerous benefits available to member agencies; and

WHEREAS, POST requires the governing body of Metro approve a resolution committing to adhere to the minimum standards for recruitment and training established by POST in order become a member agency.

NOW THEREFORE,

Section 1: The governing body of Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority declares that it desires to qualify to receive aid from the State of California under the provisions of Section 13522, Chapter 1 of Title 4, Part 4 of the California Penal Code.

Section 2: Pursuant to Sections 13510 and 13512 of said Chapter 1, the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority will adhere to the standards for recruitment and training established by the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.

Section 3: The Commission and its representatives may make such inquiries as deemed necessary to ascertain that the peace officer personnel of the Los Angeles County Transportation Authority adhere to the standards for recruitment and training established by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.
