Trump Administration Infrastructure Plan

Total Size: \$200 billion Seeks to Leverage \$800 billion in state and local funding

Breakdown:

1. \$100 billion for state and local government infrastructure projects – with federal funds capped at no more than 20% of total project costs.

2. \$50 billion for rural states – through block grants – with decision making for specific infrastructure projects to be held by Governors

3. \$20 billion for transformative projects – with federal funds being capped at no more than 80% of total project costs.

4. \$30 billion for expanding existing federal finance tools like TIFIA and RRIF, among other programs.
