Recommendation

AUTHORIZE the Chief Executive Officer to award a firm fixed price Contract No. AE138681000 to Atlas Technical Consultants, Inc. for the inspection of Metro structures and facilities in the amount of \$13,293,420 for the four-year base term, \$6,549,640 for the first two-year option, and \$7,120,053 for the second two-year option, for a total amount of \$26,963,113, effective August 5, 2026, subject to the resolution of any properly submitted protest(s).

Background

The Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) Final Transit Asset Management (TAM) Rulemaking: 49 CFR Parts 625 and 630 Final Rule, requires transit agencies to conduct inspections of locations, facilities, and other assets. Additionally, both the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and the American Public Transportation Association (APTA) require comprehensive inspections for transit structures.

Structures and Facilities Inspections Contract

- Physical Inspections: Physical inspection of 238 structures, including bridges and tunnel sections, and 234 facilities, consisting of passenger stations, administrative, and maintenance yards. Approximately 580 inspections to be conducted during the base contract years. 1,160 inspections over the life of the entire contract.
- Provide recommendations for capital replacement, rehabilitation, and maintenance projects.
- Provide mandated reporting to FTA National Transit Database. Assigning condition ratings using the Transit Economic Requirements Model (TERM 1.0 - 5.0) scale.

Next Steps

Upon Board approval, staff will execute Contract No. AE138681000 with Atlas Technical Consultants, Inc. to provide inspection services for Metro's structures, facilities, and related assets.
